Apprenticeship Overview - Fitted Furniture Installer Level 2

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## What is a Fitted Furniture Installer?

A Fitted Furniture Installer is responsible for preparing and installing furniture including kitchens, bathrooms and bedrooms. This is onsite at the customer's commercial or domestic premises. Learners taking this route will experience a wide variety of projects and interact closely with customers.

## The Content

Fitted Furniture Installers will develop the following core requirements:

### Knowledge

- Industry - General background of the furniture industry
- Organisation – Knowledge and understanding of the company
- Materials – Properties and characteristics of materials
- Customers – Knowledge and understanding of customer expectation
- Quality Standards – Know the quality standards which apply to the products and how to check these have been met
- Health, Safety and Environment

### Skills

- Maintain tools and equipment – Perform regular autonomous maintenance tasks
- Problem Solving – Identify issues, solve problems, and apply solutions
- Achieve Quality and Output Targets – Carry out work to required quality standards and output targets
- Health and Safety – Comply with all requirements and regulations at all times

### Behaviours

- Collaboration and adaptability – Listen and learn, accept changing priorities and working requirements. Work effectively within a team
- Time Management – Ability to complete work to schedule
- Pride in the workplace – Organise workspace for efficiency and effectiveness

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Fitted Furniture Installers will need to undertake all mandatory and two off the optional requirements.

## Mandatory

### Preparation:

- Transporting and handling materials

### Installation:

- Prepare location
- Measure and mark out
- Power tools and hand tools
- Assembly
- Installation

### Post installation:

- Re-Instate location
- Customer service
- Rectification/ Rework

## Optional

### Installation:

- Gluing
- Cut outs
- Cramping
- Sanding
- Veneers and laminates
- Jigs and templates
- Joints
- Fittings
- Electrical/mechanical fittings
- Finish composite worktops



## Eligibility

There are no set entry requirements, but Apprentices without a level 2 qualification in English and Maths will need to achieve this before the end of their apprenticeship. This will be delivered by the training provider as part of the apprenticeship programme.

## Qualifications

On completion of this apprenticeship, learners will hold a Level 2 apprenticeship in Fitted Furniture Installation.


## Employer commitment

- Ensure the apprentice undertakes real, productive work to be able to meet the requirements of the apprenticeship
- Allow the apprentice to attend external off-the-job training and assessments as required by the training provider
- Take part in reviews, support and feedback with the apprentice and training provider

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## End Point Assessment (EPA)

The End Point Assessment is an independent assessment of the knowledge, skills and behaviours which have been learnt throughout the apprenticeship and tests the apprentice's ability to apply them in the workplace





### 01 Knowledge Test

The apprentice undertakes 2 multiple-choice tests covering the core modules in health and safety and the industry.

### 02 Portfolio Assessment

The apprentice will prepare and submit a portfolio of work demonstrating the specific work-related tasks that they have completed to show how they have achieved both the core and occupational requirements.



### Observation

The observed assessment will take approximately 2 hours and will cover all the core skills, knowledge and behaviours as well as the occupational requirements.



The End Point Assessment (EPA) is conducted by a specialist End Point Assessment Organisation (EPAO) and on completion the apprentice will be awarded a Pass, Merit or Distinction. The training provider will liaise with you as the employer when arranging all aspects of the EPA.
